



We have been doing more learning around the story of Cinderella. We have been thinking of different adjectives to describe the characters in the story. We will be holding our ball on Friday 20th October. The aim is for the children to design and make all the items they need. We talked about clothes you wear to a ball so it will be a non-uniform day.

We have been looking for signs of autumn. In outdoor learning, we have completed a scavenger hunt and talked about the items we have found. We also learnt about appropriate clothes to wear in autumn including the importance of bringing a coat to school.

During circle times, we have been playing listening games to help us to make sure that we are following the Golden Rule of "we listen." These games have included Chinese whispers and pass the clap.

At home you could:

- ☺ Practise counting in 2's, 5's and 10's forwards and backwards from numbers other than 0
- ☺ Draw a picture of a character from Cinderella and talk to your child about what that character is like.
- ☺ Look out for different signs of autumn with your child; play a game of eye spy.
