For Bonfire Night, we wrote sentences to describe fireworks. We also created firework patterns using PVA glue and different coloured powder paints.



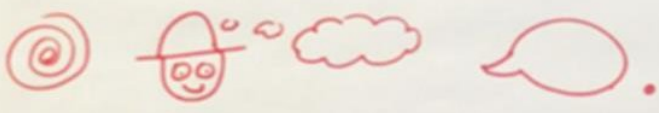
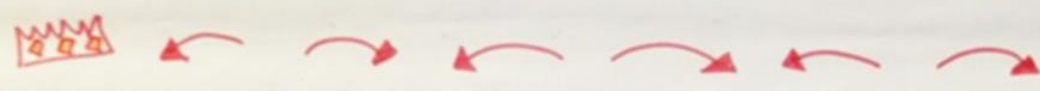
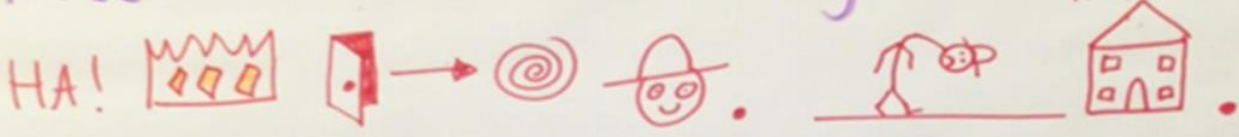
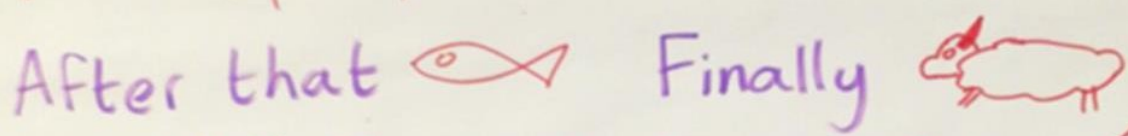
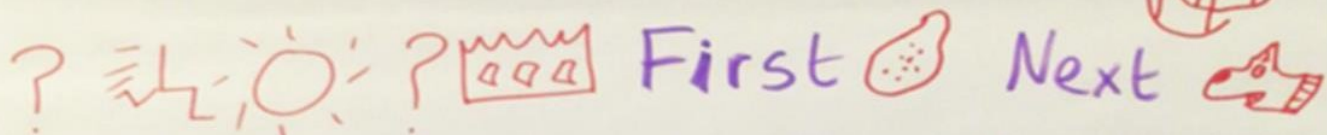
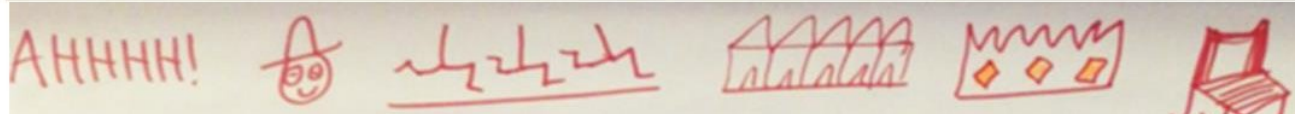
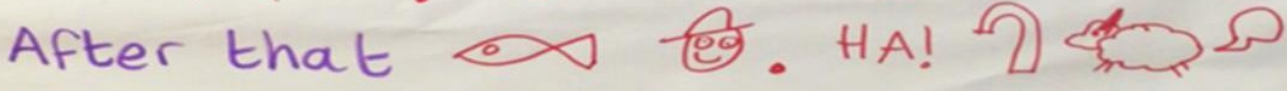
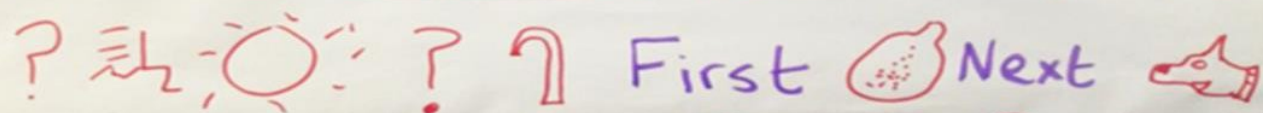
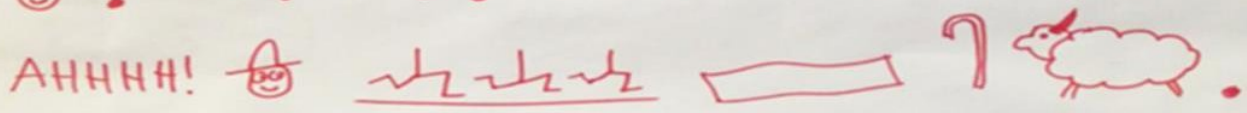
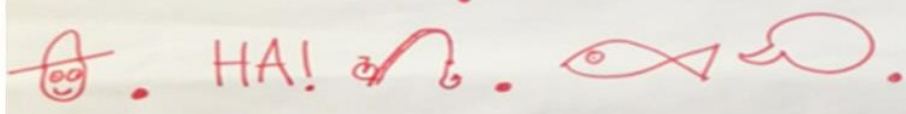
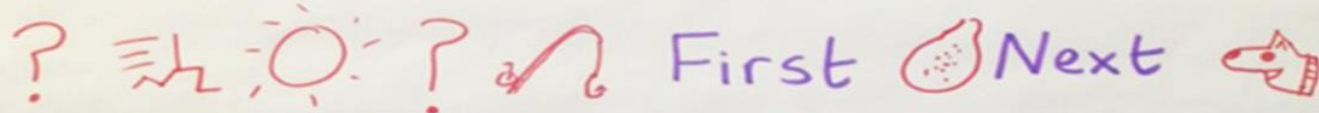
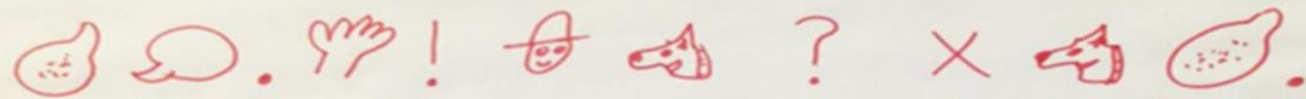
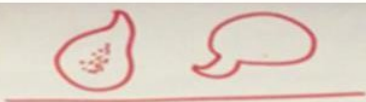
Year 2 have all been lucky enough to have campfire sessions this week. We learnt about different materials used to make campfires and toasted bread on a stick.
