Behaviour and Safety

To work with Norfolk Healthy Schools to introduce PATHS promoting alternative thinking strategies as part of PSHE provision for all children.

Develop pupil's e-safety awareness and skills through implementation of a progressive scheme of work and effective use of CEOP materials across the school.

Curriculum and assessment

Review of school tracking and formative assessment systems using assessment without levels.

To make effective use of assessment information to ensure that the level of challenge, nurture and support in lessons for all learners, including the most able pupils, is adapted frequently.

To review core purpose of subject leadership to enable all leaders to plan, develop and monitor curriculum provision for all subjects across the school.

Achievement

To raise standards in Maths- informed by analysis of all available data and review of current action plan/national developments.
