Welcome to the Summer Term! Please see the curriculum overview on the reverse, for the areas of learning we are covering this half-term.

We have been pleased to see that many Year 2 children have improved their spelling accuracy by practising the weekly focus words at home. New spellings for this half-term will be coming home soon.

Maths Skills to reinforce at home are:

- telling the time (including quarter past and quarter to, then to the nearest five minutes).
- recognising the value of different coins and counting money.
- counting back in 10s from any number, for example 87, 77, 67, 57...
- counting back in 1s from numbers over 100, for example 103, 102, 101, 100, 99,
